**WHEREAS** the Canada Labour Relations Board, by Order dated February 15, 1993, certified the Association of Postal Officials of Canada as the bargaining agent for a unit of employees of Canada Post Corporation;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Canada Labour Relations Board has received an application from the applicant for review, pursuant to section 18 of the Canada Labour Code (Part I -Industrial Relations), seeking to amend the said Order by amending the the scope of the bargaining unit;

**AND WHEREAS**, following consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned and pursuant to an agreement entered into by the parties, the Board has determined that it is appropriate to grant the application;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is ordered by the Canada Labour Relations Board that the said Order of Certification be amended, and it is hereby amended, by deleting the description of the certified bargaining unit contained therein and by substituting therefor the following:

*"all supervisory employees of Canada Post Corporation below organizational level I, involved in mail operations, mail operations support and quality control, including superintendents of postal stations and letter carrier depots, sales representatives and those involved in supervision of admail and revenue protection, excluding personnel involved in network planning,*
